## ACADEMIC REPORT 2022/2023 SESSION

We are delighted to take this opportunity to recognize and applaud the exceptional commitment to academic excellence of our students. Their journey through this session has been nothing short of remarkable, marked by dedication, diligence, and an unwavering pursuit of knowledge.

Throughout this session, we recorded improvements in the general academic performance of our students:

-Five (5) female SS3 Graduating Students from Sacred Heart Girls Model Secondary School Ubiaja with excellent results in their external examination (WAEC AND NECO)

-Two (2) Female JSS 3 students promoted to SS 1 from Sacred Heart Girls Model Secondary School Ubiaja with excellent results in their external examination (WAEC AND NECO)

-Three (3) Male JSS 3 students promoted to SS 1 from Edo College Benin City with excellent results in their external examination (WAEC AND NECO)

-Five (5) Male JSS 2 students promoted to JSS3 from Edo College Benin City with accelerating academic performance in their first, second and third term examination.

-Six (6) Female JSS 2 students promoted to JSS3 from Sacred Heart Girls Model Secondary School Ubiaja with accelerating academic performance in their first, second and third term examinations.

-Three (3) Female JSS 2 students were promoted to JSS3 from Idia College Benin City with progressive academic performance in their first, second and third term examinations.

-One (!) Female JSS 2 student was promoted to JSS3 from Federal Government Girls College with progressive academic performance in her first, second and third term examinations.

-Seven (7) Orphans (4 Males and 3 Females) from different Orphanages all promoted to the next class.

We also recorded outstanding academic performance from our student; Osamudiamen Christopher sponsored by Bella Homes NG who received an external scholarship of 250k cash prize for the best graduating student in his class.

Another Student; Aigedomwan Theodora sponsored by Mrs Susan Osagiede, was also awarded the best student in her class with cash prizes.

Indeed it is a year obviously better than the previous academic session.

## D. FINANCIAL SUMMARY FOR THIS SESSION

**TOTAL INFLOW** = 6,119,100

**DEFICIT:** -557,200

***-Arise Education Scholarship Foundation faced some setbacks financially owing to the sudden withdrawal of some sponsors from fulfilling their Financial obligation. This led to the foundation owing some schools at some point during the session. Thanks to the fire brigade response of the foundation's Founder/Chairman; Mr Rex Osagiede in clearing the financial deficit of 557,200. By this swift response, all outstanding fees were paid and we are now left with some cash to begin the next academic session.***

### NOTE.

- AESF still owes Mustard Seed Secondary School (the school of Godstime Eghosa; an orphan) an unresolved amount of money. This is because we have not been able to reach out to the school or a serious representative from the Orphans home concerned. The amount paid to the school so far is for first and second term fees (i.e. 84,400)
